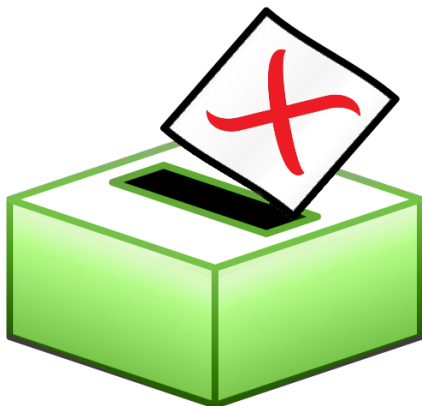




Vote **NO**
